How to Manage Problem Behavior

About the workshop

This workshop was created for parents and caregivers of individuals diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and other developmental disabilities who engage in mild to moderate problem behavior that is disruptive to their daily lives.

This 2-part workshop will aim to help caregivers recognize the reasons behind their child's problem behavior, provide training on how to use this information to develop interventions, and provide specific recommendations on how to implement those treatments. There will be discussion of common pitfalls encountered by caregivers who are dealing with problem behaviors. Attendees will leave with strategies to reduce problem behavior and to encourage more appropriate behavior.
