How to Manage Problem Behavior

About the workshop

This workshop was created for caregivers of individuals diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and other developmental disabilities who engage in mild to moderate problem behavior that is disruptive to their daily lives.

This 2-part workshop will help caregivers recognize the reasons behind your child's problem behavior, learn how to use this information to develop interventions, and provide specific recommendations that families can use at home. There will be discussion of common pitfalls encountered by caregivers when dealing with problem behaviors. Attendees will leave with strategies to encourage more appropriate behavior.
