Understanding the IEP - Series

This workshop was created for parents and caregivers of individuals diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and other developmental disabilities who want to understand more about working with schools through the Individualized Education Program (IEP) process.

The first presentation will cover the components of the IEP. We will discuss the IEP team, how to prepare for meetings, and placement options. The second presentation will cover IEP Goal Writing, will review how to select and write goals for their children. Parents are encouraged to bring current IEPs to review individually. This workshop series is appropriate for a parent or caregiver who wishes to work collaboratively with their school and those who have children enrolling in public education for the first time.
