The goal of the workshop is to teach you how to select the right language modality (speech, sign language, pictures, etc.) for your child, select the right words to start with, and to start building your child's communication skills. This workshop is appropriate for parents, caregivers, or professionals who wish to learn more about initial communication and how to set a solid foundation for learning.
