Are you wondering if your child is ready to
be toilet trained?*

This workshop was created for parents and caregivers of individuals diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and other developmental disabilities who have toileting concerns. In this 2-part workshop, the primary focus will be on urine training and will give parents several strategies to increase toileting success at home.
